Moira Shire Council awarded iDwala the re-construction project for the upgrade of two netball courts at Katamatite Recreation Reserve in Katamatite. Council worked with the Katamatite Tigers Netball Club on the project which formed part of the council's wider brief of creating sustainable recreation facilities within the Shire that could be used by the community all year round.

Prior to the court upgrade works performed, the court flooring was an unforgiving bitumen surface. The original surface was in need of an upgrade to a modern and compliant surface, that was more comfortable and safe for the players to utilise in all weather conditions. The resulting new green and red courts installed by the iDwala team are Netball Victoria compliant and were surfaced using Australian made Podium Surfaces material for a durable and UV stable surface.

Moira Shire Council and The Katamatite Football Netball Club officially opened the courts in April of 2022 in time for the upcoming netball season. The new netball courts formed part of a multi-sport district including the neighbouring Katamatite Football Club, and are sure to be a meeting point where the local community can come together and enjoy their sport for many generations to come.
